The Litecox company and the Zendegi company have first met in Turkey, at the International Festival for young audience of Bursa in **October 2014**.

Both companies have an authentical interest in collaboration with other countries and cultures, in sharing with artists from all over the world.

For example, Litecox with Algeria and Turkey, Zendegi with Germany and Canada.

NOVEMBER 2015 : Workshop and showing in Tehran and Isfahan – Iran

First step in our collaboration, the Iranian company Zendegi Theater from Tehran has invited the Litécox company to participate to the 2nd Aban International acting and Movement Workshop in Tehran from 15th to 22th November 2015. Five French and German artists have been invited to this event.

Daisy Fel has led the choreographic workshops in the National Dramatic Art Center, assisted by two dancers from the Litécox company ; Laetitia Naud and Béatrice Garnier. They also realized a performance in Tehran.

This show touches in a metaphorical way, many questions about the actual society and today's world.

The question of freedom of expression :

The question about the intergenerational relationships, Men/Women relationships, the two charaters of the show being an old pencil and a young eraser.

In a philosophical way ; the universality of emotions.

Words are really present everywhere during the show wich since the beginning of its creation revolves around language : the common language wich allows us to comunicate is English, but we have our personal one, Farsi and his persian alphabet and French with his latin alphabet.

> All along this piece audience can hear or see words : - spoken in the soundtrack - projected in the video for scenography - shouted, whispered, sung or danced by comedian and dancer



Soundtrack of the show travels across the world with different musics :

from Iran, with santoor and from France, with accordion, two very specific and traditionnal instruments of both countries.

Music travels also across time with nowaday's music, like techno or electro music and american contemporary music.

Steve Reich, Jafar Mahayari, Jean-François Minjard, John Zorn, Zadig, Olaf, Richard Galliano, Kobosil are some of the composers.



Story of pencil and eraser

It's the story of an old pencil and a young eraser who lived in a pencil case.

They haven't got any news from the owner since a long time yet.

He was used to write negative things his his pencil, and to erase all positive ones with his eraser.

That is why they decide to go out of their pencil case, writing and erasing whatever they want to. They will finally succeed their escape after many strifes, and will have to go through many hardships and troubles.

Artistic Director of Zendegi Theater Company Graduated in the field of Acting from Sooreh Art College www.zendegitheater.com



After graduated from the Art University of Sooreh, Jafar continued his studies in art and visual field alongside the Canadian compagny San Argos. After obtaining his degree, he got back to studies a last time and joined the University of Tehran where he got the certificate of Visual Creativity.

Then he develops his managment skills by becoming a co-founderof the Board workshops Boomerang Theater in 2006. After that he became manager of Zendegi theater compagny in 2010. Then he helps in the coordiantion and implementation of various projects of national and international workshops through Iran.

Since 2014 Jafar also teach acting in various schools like the Fine Arts for exemple. Allowing him to develop certain skills in teaching, particulary through his participation in numerous workshop since he's active in the crative and artistic fields.

He received some nominations and awards throughout his various participations in festivals and conventions, like the award for the best show at the Noble Festival in Tunisia with his show : Gol Show. Jafar is particularly active in his field, in fact he is a permanent member of the Iranian National Center Stage and three other organization in the cultural sphere.





Artistic Director and Choreographer of the Litecox Compagny

Daisy Fel started to practice dance trough improvisation with musicians from the LMC – London's Musicians Collective – and begin to form at the Graham school - The Place - as well at the Rosemary Butcher and Richard Alston courses.

She continue her training of contemporary dance with Kilina Cremona, Roger Meguin and Michel Hallet-Eghayan. She's very impressed by Odile Duboc, during a stage with her and Barre Philips ; then by Trisha Brown during an other stage in Avignon. A saison passed with Christiane Viricel will mark her work in staging and composition.

Co founder of the « Instant T » collective in Saint-Etienne in 1983, she create the actual Litecox compagny in 1990. She regularly carries performances with musicians, Nicolas Allemand, Guillaume Orti, Philippe Bourlois and the members of the ARFI. For her creations, Daisy Fel work in close collaboration with visual artists, Carmelo Zagari, Jean-François Gavoty, Bruno and Marino Thery, Euan Burnett-Smith, Olivier Bouton, some compositors, Jean-François Minjard, Michel Mandel, François Payrastre and lately with the singer Ilhem Dehimi.

Otherwise, accorded to the artistic career of Daisy Fel, formation and sensitization to the dance is a big part in the work of the compagny ; organized and carry out by stages, workshops, animations and conferences, witch match to that wish to open the space inbetween creation and formation.



Actor & Puppeteer & Writer Acting Conservatory graduate Tehran - Iran



Since his inception in the artistic field in 1995, Saeed was involved in many cultural works in Iran. From 1996 to 2016, he took part in thirty-one shows as an actor holder. As well as five other rooms as puppeteer. It is in more than thirty-five different compositions for almost twenty years that Saeed was able to develop his skills in theater and arts fields.

His talents and skills have been shown at various festivals where he get awarded by the jury from 1997 to 2015. In particular the title of best actor at the Institute for Child Development and young adults in 2012. He received as well seven other awards for various roles since his debut in theater.

Since 2010 Saeed also participates in several international festivals throughout Europe and North Africa. He also received different lessons from abroad during his participation in several workshops held by compagnies from Canada and Belgium for example.





Béatrice Garnier

Beatrice followed a multidisciplinary teaching focused on classical dance during 8 years at the Avignon conservatory and at Mudra, international school of Maurice Béjard at Bruxelles. At 18 years old, she joined one after one two compagny : « Le ballet Français de Nancy » (The french ballet of Nancy) under artistic direction of Hélène Trailine, Patrick Dupont and Pierre Lacoste, then the « Théâtre de Mannheim » (The Mannheim theater) lead by Philippe Talard, former dancer from the famous XX century Ballet.

Since her young age she knows the sustained rythm shot in France and abroad (Spain, Italy, United States, African, Japan, Swiss...) and interprets different roles of classical and neoclassical reper-

toire.

She as well dance for severals shows from famous choreographer like : Bertrand D'At, Lionel Hoch, Pierre Darde, Ulysse Doves, Daniel Larrieu. She dance alongside the ballet dancer Patrick Dupont as the main role of the show « les Illumitation » of Thierry Malandain.

In 1994 she joins the « Cie Résonance » with the choreographers Kada Godbhane and Miguel Lopez where she improve her knowledge in modern Jazz and more specificaly at the Horton technic.

In 2005 she participate to the creation « Passage », under direction of Daisy Fel for the Transsurbaines festival.

Holder of a State diploma of teaching, she naturaly comes to the education beside several structures especially in a school of REAL (Artistic Education Network of Loire) governed by the General Council of the departement. Today she teaching at the Loire Masteries at Montbrison, she it intervenes as well in several schools of the regions.

Today she's leading the artistic direction and the administration of the Trajectoires K company with the dancer choreographer Laetitia Naud, with who she shared a long professionnal career of international dancer.
